



Marathi Home Schooling for Intermediate & Advance Level students

- Shala parent must have AMM Family membership
- AMS has 2 semesters – Fall & Spring - that matches with local school district calendar
- Fall semester is the first semester and Spring semester is the second semester
- Student must register during start of each semester by paying registration fee
- Student can participate in any AMS related program performed during the AMM event
- Student can take BMM Exam (Please note that the BMM Exam is optional)

Fee structure for 'Marathi Home Schooling' Students:

- \$30 per semester - This will include study material & admin related services
- Students participating in AMS's Annual Picnic will need to pay separately

'Marathi Home Schooling' Students interested in taking the BMM Exam:

- Must have passed 'Bal Mitra 3' (BM3) exam. New student must show up in person to either 'North Austin' or 'Round Rock' branch to take the test. Test will comprise of Oral and Written exam per BMM guidelines.
- Must register with Austin Marathi Shala for both semesters
- Must complete required course material for both semesters including weekly homework (Student is expected to study every week & submit the homework electronically – E.g. scan/picture)
- If student approaches AMS in the Spring semester, then that student must complete the course work for Fall semester first, by paying the registration fee for the Fall semester, before studying Spring semester coursework
- It is mandatory to take Fall semester exam & Spring semester's mid Term exams to get exposure to Oral Exam section of BMM Exam (AMS Teachers will guide students that need any improvement. Depending upon overall grade, AMS teachers will recommend if the student should take the BMM exam or not)
- There will be a \$30 Exam fee that includes BMM Exam registration fee & Exam admin expense (Please note that there is no refund for Exam fee)
- BMM Exam form must be submitted along with Exam fee on or before the due date
- BMM Exam rescheduling fee: \$10 (Non-illness related reschedules must be done one week before the Exam and illness related reschedule must be done within one week after the Exam)
